Activities | Results

- To Dynamize Strengthening productive and local economy systems namely through:
 - Supporting the implementation and dissemination of an eco-rural production model;
 - Helping sustainable fishing activities;
 - Supporting local economy enhancement.;
 - Developing an environmental and cultural based tourism proposal;
 - Establishing and implementing a socioeconomic and cultural monitoring system of the CMPA.
- Reinforcing the access to basic social services namely through:
 - Constructing new water points and rehabilitate/improve the existing ones;
 - Promoting cleaning and waste reuse campaigns in tabankas;
 - Promoting teaching quality;
 - Promoting health quality;
 - Supporting social infrastructure rehabilitation;
 - Creating and boosting an information and communication technologies centre.
- Promoting the operability of the community management units of CMPA, mainly:
 - Ensuring the transfer of the maritime surveillance system to the Biodiversity and Protected Areas Institute (IBAP, in Portuguese);
 - Supporting the AMPC's community management and governance organs;
 - Establishing and implementing the AMPC's socioeconomic and cultural monitoring system.
