

TERMS OF REFERENCE

Call for the Recruitment of Design and Supervising Engineer for the Refurbishment of Youth Centres in Basse (URR) and Bansang (CRR)

Background

IMVF and three partners (United Purpose -UP, Agency for Development of Women and Children - ADWAC and Alianza por la Solidaridad) are implementing a project under the Tekki Fii programme funded by the EU Trust Fund for Africa.

The action will support the role of local organizations – namely, community radios, youth groups, CBOs and SCOs – as providers of services, social facilities and spaces for community encounters and dialogues. The implementation of social services and facilities and the strengthening of community organizations, together with the more economic oriented intervention, will promote youth and women engagement in rural development and provide a favourable social backdrop for the reintegration of migrants in the targeted regions.

In line with the priorities of the National Development Plan 2018-2021, IMVF and partners in collaboration with National Youth Council of the Gambia consider renovating and refurbish the existing Regional Youth Centres in Basse (Upper River Region) and in Bansang (Central River Region). These centers are intended to be used as a hub the following activities:

- **Entrepreneurship activities** (e.g. catering services, IT services and rental of halls and provision of accommodation services)
- **Sporting activities for leisure** (basketball, volleyball and any lawn related sports among other in door games)
- **Social activities** (hosting of community events)
- **Information sharing** (labour market information center, migration information center, sexual and reproductive health education center and office spaces)
- **Educational activities** (Library, Information Technology training center and internet service provision)

Scope of work

The assignment comprises of an assessment of the youth centres in Basse and Bansang to determine and estimate the required renovation and refurbishment needs and establish the bills of quantities. The Youth Centres include a main building (hall) and adjacent facilities, offices and toilets. The youth centres in these locations also include basketball courts. The assessment should:

- Cover all existing structures that are part of the youth centres in Basse, Bansang as well as access to electricity and water;
- Include views and preferences from the respective stakeholders led by the National Youth Council, Regional Youth Committee and Centre Management Committee;
- Determine the repair measures needed;
- Estimate the cost for material and workmanship;
- Estimate duration for works;
- Prioritize repair work based on necessity;
- Identify potential local suppliers, priority should be given to youth-owned or oriented service providers including members of the community that are directly affected by the youth centre.

Calendar

The assessment shall be undertaken for 3 weeks and shall start immediately after contract signature.
