**Instituto Marquês de Valle Flôr Statutes, referred to in the Decree No. 38:351,
of August 1st, 1951.**

CHAPTER I

Name, headquarters, purpose and duration

Article 1 To perpetuate the memory of her husband, the Marquis of Valle Flôr, and that of her son José Luís de Valle Flôr, 2nd Marquis of Valle Flôr, is founded in Lisbon by D. Maria do Carmo Dias Constantino Ferreira Pinto, Marquise of Valle Flôr, a establishment for scientific research, to be called Instituto Marquês de Valle Flôr.

Art. 2 This establishment...

Art. 24 Once these statutes have been approved and published, the Institute will be considered to have been created from the outset, and it may begin to function immediately, although its definitive installation at the Valle Flôr Palace will depend on the assignment provided for in the sole paragraph of Article 3 and on the will or death of the founder, Marquise of Valle Flôr.
